Dear Parents and Students,

Our trip is coming up very fast! I just wanted to mention, before we get to the nuts and bolts of the packing list, that the most important thing you can bring to Flint is a great attitude and a willingness to serve. Be prayerful about the week leading up to Flint and make sure your heart is in the right place. God can use this trip to truly change your whole perspective on life! Onto the list itself!

*Note: We work 4 days of the week. Our beach day is Wednesday! We are gone for 6 days total!

What To Bring:

- Clothes to work/paint in (Double check this selection with parents as some of these will not be “wearable” after our week is through! Please bring layers in case of cooler weather)
- Close-toed shoes to work/paint in
- Dirty Clothes Bag
- Sandals/Flip-flops
- Clean clothes to change into after our work day
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo/conditioner, deodorant, toothbrush & toothpaste)
- Shower Shoes
- Cot/Air Mattress, Sleeping Pad
- Bedding (Blankets, sleeping bag, pillow, etc.)
- Bathing Suit
- 2 Towels
- Sunglasses
- Hat (might get paint on it!)
- Sun Screen
- Flashlight
- Bible
- Notebook
- Writing Utensils
- Fan
- Extension Cords / Power Strips
- Medications should be checked in with your leaders**

Optional:

Card/Board Game (age appropriate)

Earplugs

Snacks (please bring in sealed container or bag)

Cell Phones (if you decide to bring it) should stay in your room with your bag.

What NOT to Bring

Weapons, drugs, drug paraphernalia, anything illicit or illegal (duh)

Anything with THC

Vaping pens

Anything expensive, jewelry, Ipads, laptops, etc.
